

Blindly applying to jobs on your own and hoping that someone will "take a chance" on you without having the right education, experience, certifications, or resume is soul sucking.


Because no one responds.

The market is tough. Without the right skills and experience on your resume, recruiters and hiring teams are likely to overlook your resume.

And when you do land an interview...

The interview is a flop. Without the right skills or experience to back you up, you find yourself struggling to come up with the right answers to the questions that matter. The interviewer quickly picks up on the gaps, and before you know it, the opportunity slips away.

It's a harsh realization: getting the interview is only half the battle. Without proper preparation, even that lucky break can turn into a missed opportunity.



"Should I go back to school and get a tech degree? Is it necessary?"

The truthful answer is... while a tech degree can be helpful, it's certainly not the only path to landing a role as a business analyst or product owner, nor does a degree guarantee that you'll successfully land a role.

At the end of the day, organizations really care about the right combination of skills, hands-on experience, and certifications that prove your ability to do the job. Employers are generally more focused on what you can do rather than where or what you've studied.



Normal Program Sessions

Unless there are special circumstance, our live sessions usually take place Monday through Thursday 7-9:30pm CST. You will attend live sessions 1-3 times a week from the time you start the program until you land a role, depending on where you are in the program.



1:1 Sessions

1:1 sessions are available throughout the week. Times vary based on the ability of you and the mentor mentor/team member you are booking a 1:1 with. There is a list of mentors available to meet with you along with their booking calendars in the student portal.



Continuous Learning Sessions

We offer continuous learning sessions as our mentors have availability and learners request them. These sessions are usually offered on Sunday evenings or during the week when the majority of individuals don't have other classes. These sessions are open to current students as well as alumni.



2 Industry Certifications

Like them or hate them, certifications offer you professional credibility and a competitive edge against non-certified peers.

As you go through the program, you'll work to earn two industry-recognized certifications. The first certification is ICAgile's Agile Fundamentals. This is a self-paced course that you'll work through in the first three weeks of the program.

The second certification is Agile Product Ownership (APO) and certifies you as a product owner. This is a live, attendance/participation based class that consistently receives a 5 star rating.

We cover the cost of both the Agile Fundamentals and APO certifications through our organization.





Branding, Resume, and Interview Support

LinkedIn Branding & Resume

You'll work together with someone on the team to determine your new and transferrable skills. Together, you'll update your resume and LinkedIn profile to help you stand out as a qualified candidate.

We mentioned organizations care about what work you've done, and we briefly mentioned that you'll work with software engineers and product mentors on a product build. But what will you actually do?


In the end, we can't give you *exactly* the same experience that you'll have working in an organization. However...

- Present product updates and findings to peers and mentors for constructive feedback


