

Without proper preparation, even that lucky break can turn into a missed opportunity.

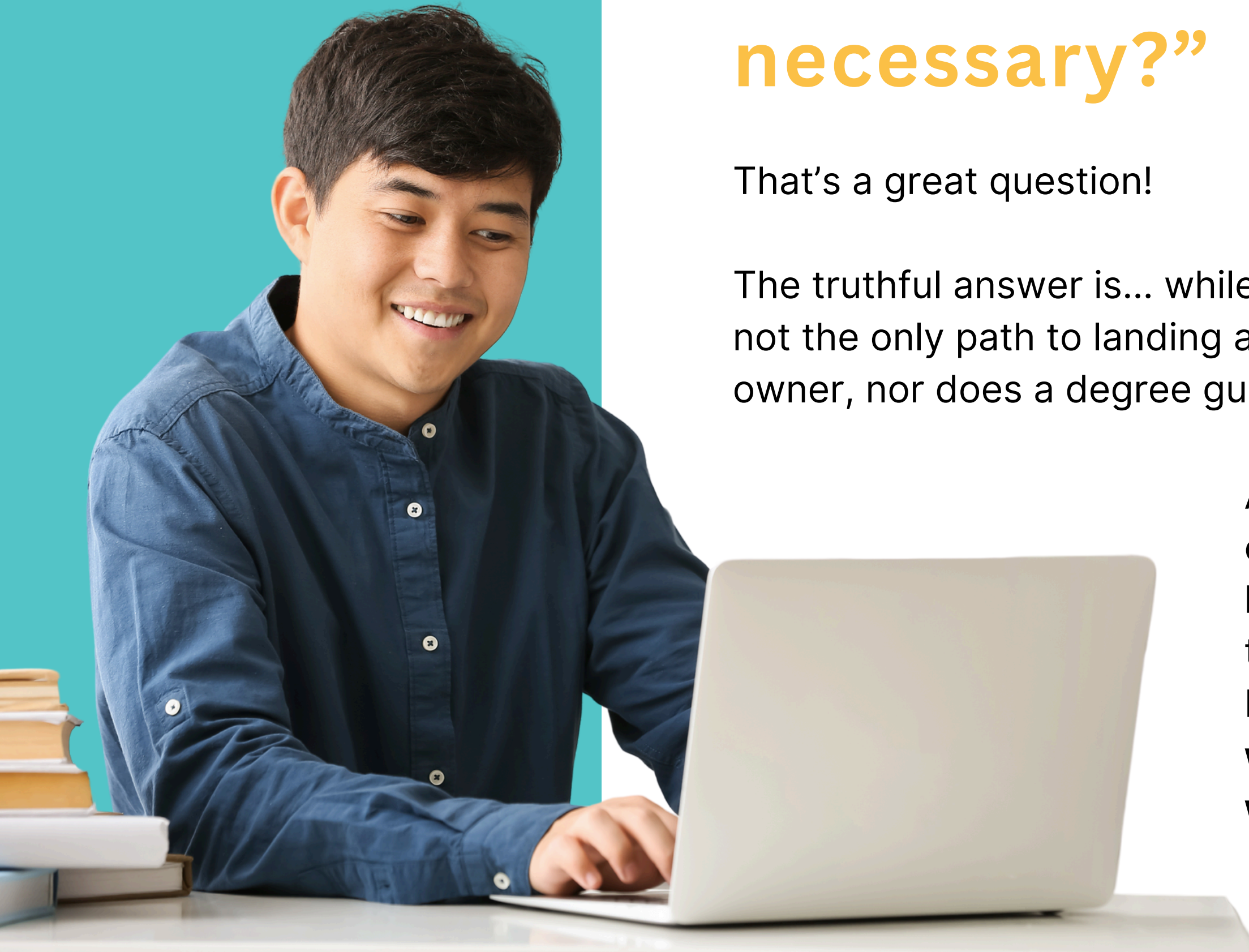

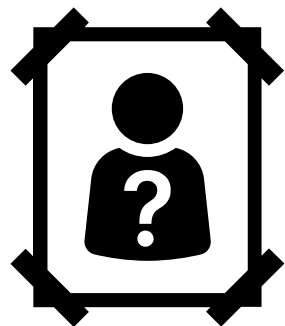
Money

Normal Program Sessions

Unless there are special circumstance, our live sessions usually take place Monday through Thursday 7-9:30pm CST. You will attend live sessions 1-3 times a week from the time you start the program until you land a role, depending on where you are in the program.



1:1 Sessions

1:1 sessions are available throughout the week. Times vary based on the ability of you and the mentor mentor/team member you are booking a 1:1 with. There is a list of mentors available to meet with you along with their booking calendars in the student portal.



Continuous Learning Sessions

We offer continuous learning sessions as our mentors have availability and learners request them. These sessions are usually offered on Sunday evenings or during the week when the majority of individuals don't have other classes. These sessions are open to current students as well as alumni.



2 Industry Certifications

Like them or hate them, certifications offer you professional credibility and a competitive edge against non-certified peers.

As you go through the program, you'll work to earn two industry-recognized certifications. The first certification is ICAgile's Agile Fundamentals. This is a self-paced course that you'll work through in the first three weeks of the program.

The second certification is Agile Product Ownership (APO) and certifies you as a product owner. This is a live, attendance/participation based class that consistently receives a 5 star rating.

We cover the cost of both the Agile Fundamentals and APO certifications through our organization.



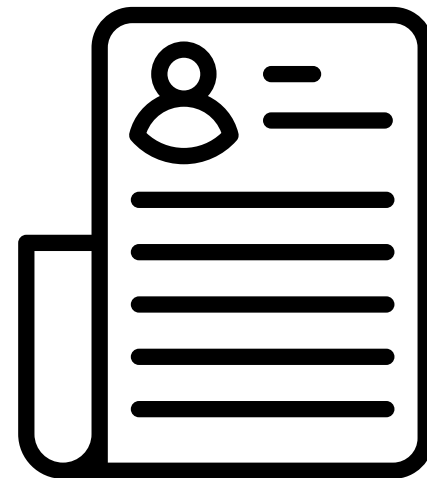

In the end, we can't give you **exactly** the same experience that you'll have working in an organization. However...

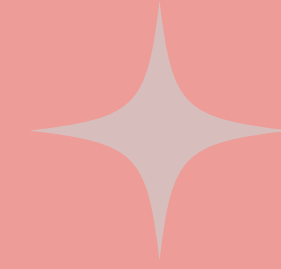
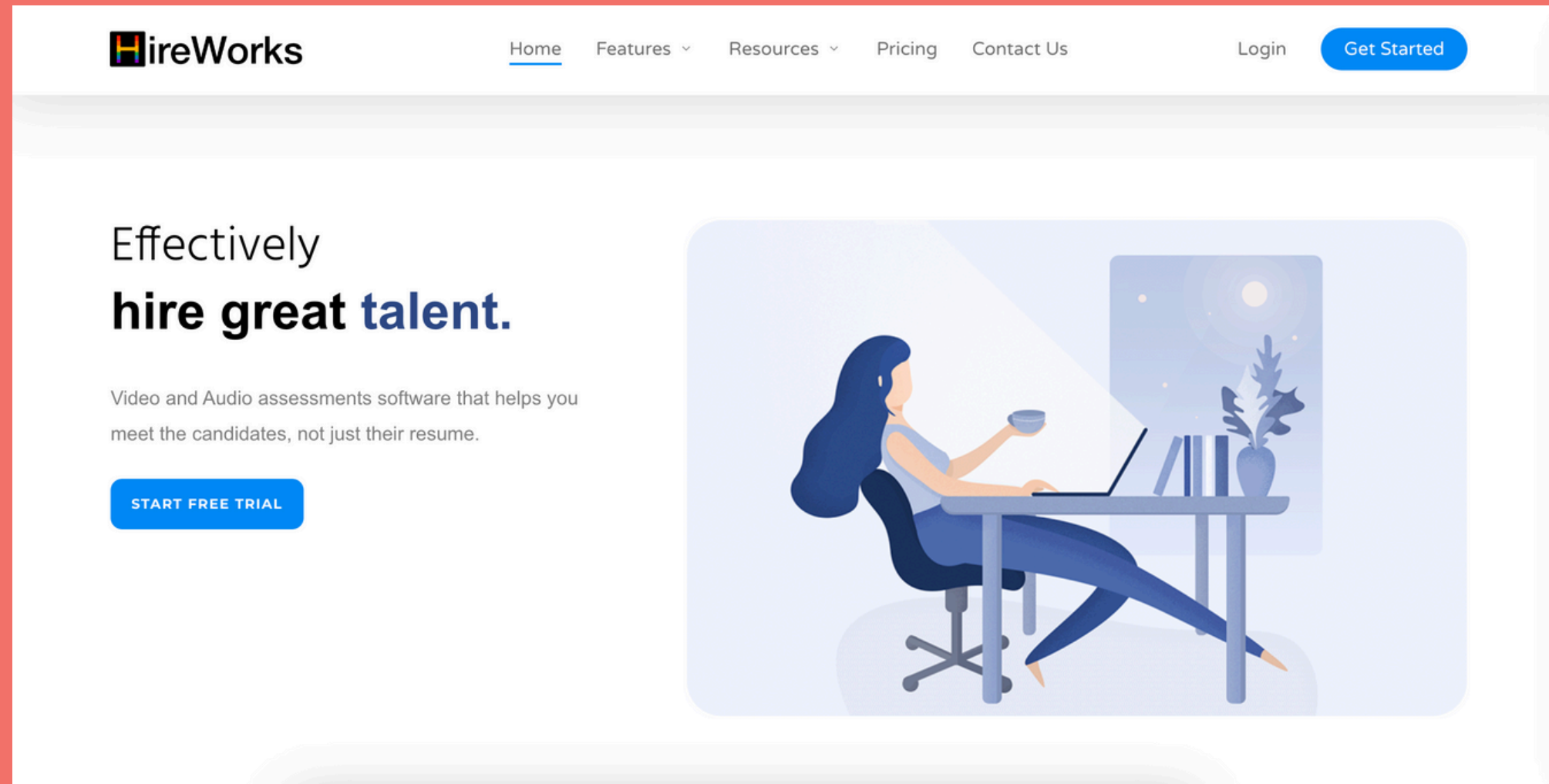

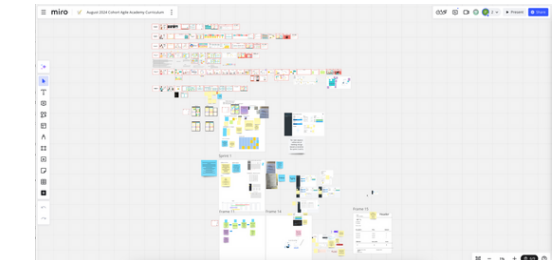
Working Agreement for Cloud Balance

KEY AGREEMENTS	
Communication	
Time	Members will be 100%
Code	Everyone checks Code daily for updates. Download an app on your phone for easy access. If a response is required, respond within a timely manner (i.e. 24 hours)
WhatsApp	A WhatsApp group has been created and is used for daily updates
Missed Session	Let the group know if you are not able to make a meeting or session. The group will record meetings for people that are not able and update them with what they have missed.
Working Hours	Let the group know if you are not able to attend, and your answer to the three sets of questions. Try to attend the meeting. If you are unable, let the group know to get the information you missed and use the CRIC app to see what we are working on.
No Distractions	No phones, try to be as present as possible in a quiet place. Tablets internet, if you're attending etc. No work on phone.
Support	If you need support, you will reach out to your peers or mentors first and then Module 1 if necessary.
Helping	There is a safe place to learn from each other and get help. Communication on helping is open. Check on each other and be a contributing factor in a respectful, helpful environment. Don't be afraid to ask or provide any support. Don't be afraid to ask for help. Appearance is not allowed, pronunciation of names, cultural acceptance.
Breaks	Allow a 15 minute break after every 45 minute session.
Camera	Try to get camera production and honest communication. During meetings everyone should try to keep their camera on, unless there are circumstances that make one unable.
Spitting work	Everyone gets the feedback so that one person is not doing more than the other. Communication if you are uncomfortable with the work.

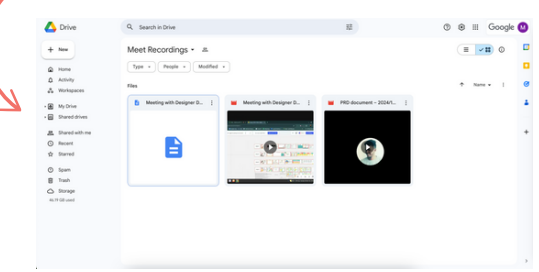
